## RULES

The regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing 2009-2012*.

The rules of the Footy class will apply except where amended below.

**1.3** By participating in this regatta, a competitor grants to the organizing authority and its sponsors the right in perpetuity to make, use and show, from time to time at their discretion, any photographs, motion pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of him or her during the period of the competition without compensation.

## BOATS/MEASUREMENT

Hulls and decks shall essentially be made of wood, and should be able to retain integrity if reinforcing materials were eliminated. This is a WoodenBoat regatta and the spirit of compliance is expected. Eligibility will be decided by the organizers whose decision is final.

Boats shall comply with the Footy measurement

with the exception that sail numbers must be a good faith effort to number your boat, but registration is not required.

**FEES** – There is no entry fee for the race, there is an entry fee to Mystic Seaport for the show, and this will not be waived for competitors

**SAILING INSTRUCTIONS** - The sailing instructions will be available at registration.

**SCORING** – Scoring shall take the form of First one point, second two points and etcetera, there is one throwout allowed. Competitors are encouraged to allow bystanders to race their Footys, and to that end, if a bystander is racing a competitors footy, the competitor shall bring it to the notice of the race committee and that boat will be allowed it's average result minus one point for that race, this ruling shall stand even if the bystander scores less than the average for that boat. A boat may be raced by someone other than the skipper in a maximum of two races.

**PRIZES** – Prizes shall be given for First, Second and Third. Spirit of Wooden boat and Concours de Elegance.
